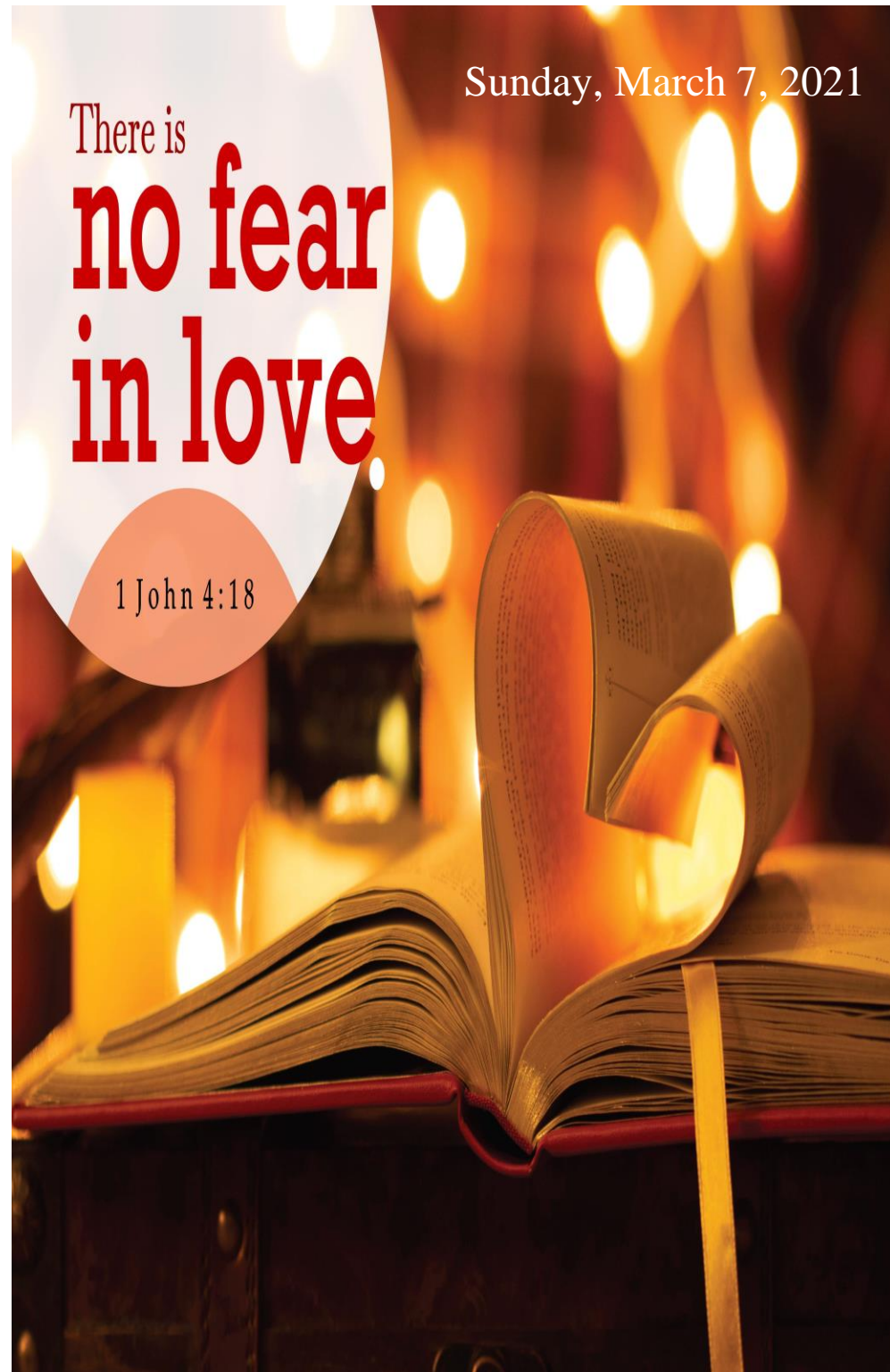

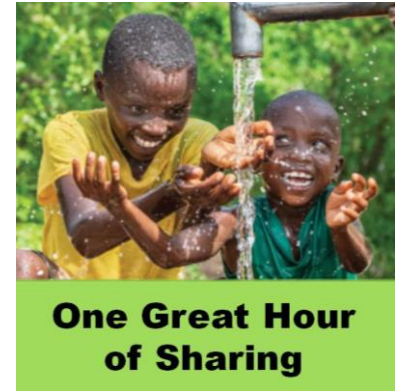

## Church Security



The Property Team is moving forward with changing the church's security system. They have targeted the date of April 4<sup>th</sup> for the first day of the new system. The "traditional" keys to the church will no longer be operational on the external entry doors. At this initial juncture, those persons in leadership roles (Team Chairs, Property, Stewards, Custodial, Leadership, and paid staff) will be issued fobs. If you are outside of those designated areas and feel you need the use of a fob, please contact the church office and your request will be reviewed.

- Please note that the system will be programmed to allow access to the church for any scheduled meetings or events without the use of a fob.
- Also note that in order to receive a fob for any reason, you must submit and maintain current Criminal and Child Abuse Clearances. Your fob will not be activated until you have submitted these forms.
- The Property Team is requesting that you turn in any existing keys to the building unless you need them for interior door access.
- The Church Administrator will serve as the administrator of the system and will be in charge of scheduling and changes.
- Stay tuned for updates as they become available.
