I cannot know for certain where it will end.

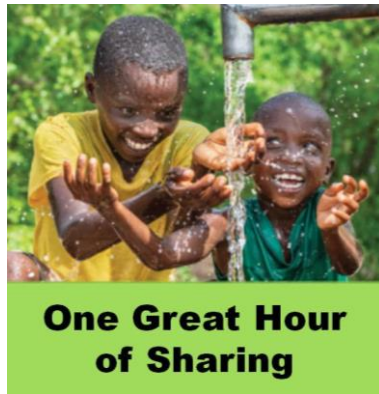
Nor do I really know myself,

Hempfield Area and Manheim Central Food Pantries Needs

Currently on the needs list is pasta, pasta sauce, mac and cheese, jelly, canned pears/peaches/applesauce, peanut butter, oatmeal, cereal, baked beans, beef vegetable soup, and Spam.

- Hempfield has also requested canned corn, canned carrots, canned mixed vegetables, and dry 2 lb. packages of pinto beans.
- Manheim has also requested some personal hygiene products including tissues, and large diapers (sizes 4, 5, 6 and pull ups).
