We are supporting Afghanistan Refugee Resettlement through Church World Service (CWS) for our special offering this year. Jesus calls us to care for the outsider "I was a stranger and you took me in" (Matthew 25:35).

The Church of the Brethren has long supported refugees in our communities and encourages supporting CWS to help Afghans. Afghans fled their country quickly in August, bringing very little with them. They are fleeing retribution or persecution from the Taliban and have one goal: to live in safety. It is in our power to help them. CWS is supporting these families with housing, legal assistance, case management, mental health support, medical care, school enrollment and community sponsorship.
