<u>OUTREACH</u>: **Paul and Sandy Brubaker**, from the Elizabethtown COB will give an update on the **Haiti Medical Project** TODAY. They will share how the COB is helping Haitian people after the devastating 7.2 magnitude earthquake in August. They'll also discuss how the church is working in the midst of Haiti's violence and lawlessness.

Sandy is a board member of Center for Caring, Empowerment Peace Initiative (CCEPI), which was started by Rebecca Dali of Nigeria. CCEPI helps people impacted by terrorism, and provides education for widows and orphans in Nigeria. Rebecca and her husband, Samuel, are COB members, and Samuel was president of the Nigerian COB.

A book was written about Rebecca's life journey called "We Have Walked in Each Other's Shoes". Rebecca has suffered poverty, misogyny, discrimination, violence and because of her suffering she has a heart to help others. The book is written for middle school age children but adults enjoy it to. It's an excellent book to teach children about other children living in poverty and that education is a primary need of all people. **Sandy** will be in the narthex TODAY if you would like to buy the book. It sells for \$15 and 100% goes to the ministry of CCEPI.
