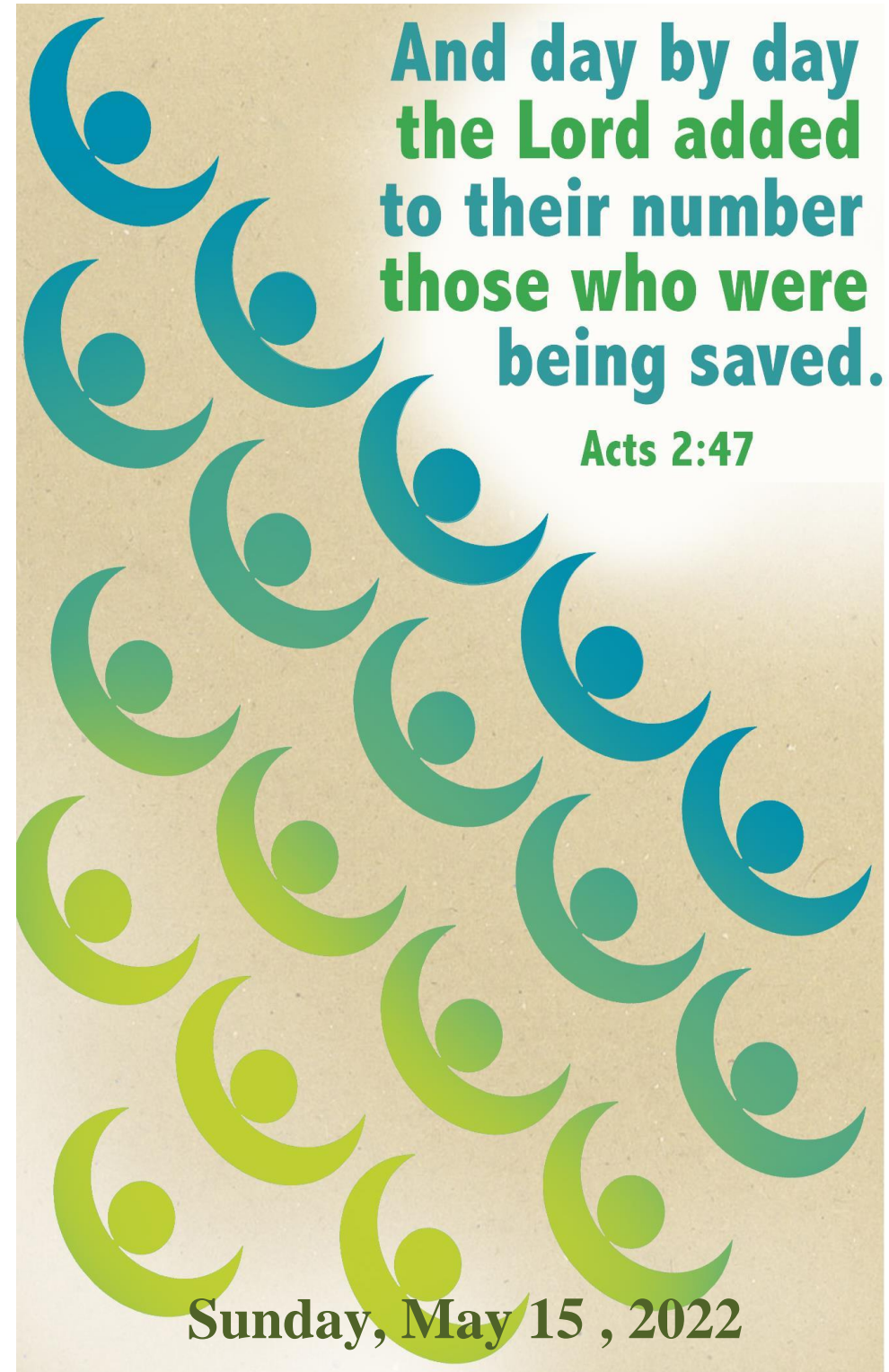

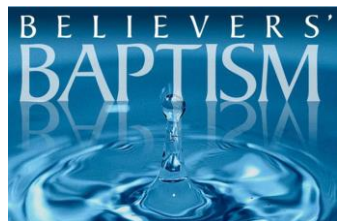

### FOOD PANTRY UPDATE -

96 pounds of food items contributed to the pantry in March.

In March we served 136 families.... which included 144 children, 268 adults, 107 seniors for a total 519 people. Many families visit the pantry every week which gives our total people fed in March at 1,570.
