#### FOOD PANTRY UPDATE -

96 pounds of food items contributed to the pantry in March.

In March we served 136 families.... which included 144 children, 268 adults, 107 seniors

for a total 519 people. Many families visit the pantry every week which gives our total people fed in March at 1,570.

**VIDEO UPGRADE FUNDRAISER:** We are kicking off a fundraiser to upgrade our church's video technology for live streaming and recording. With unanimous Leadership Team support, the congregation voted to approve the video upgrade at the April 24 Congregational Gathering.

The total cost of the project is estimated at \$20,000; \$10,000 will come from the Building Fund and \$10,000 will come from this special fundraiser. There is a possibility to receive a grant of up to \$5,000 from the Atlantic Northeast District's Facilities Assistance Fund, therefore we may only need to raise \$5,000. The application for ANE funds was sent on May 25 and we'll keep you informed of its status.




