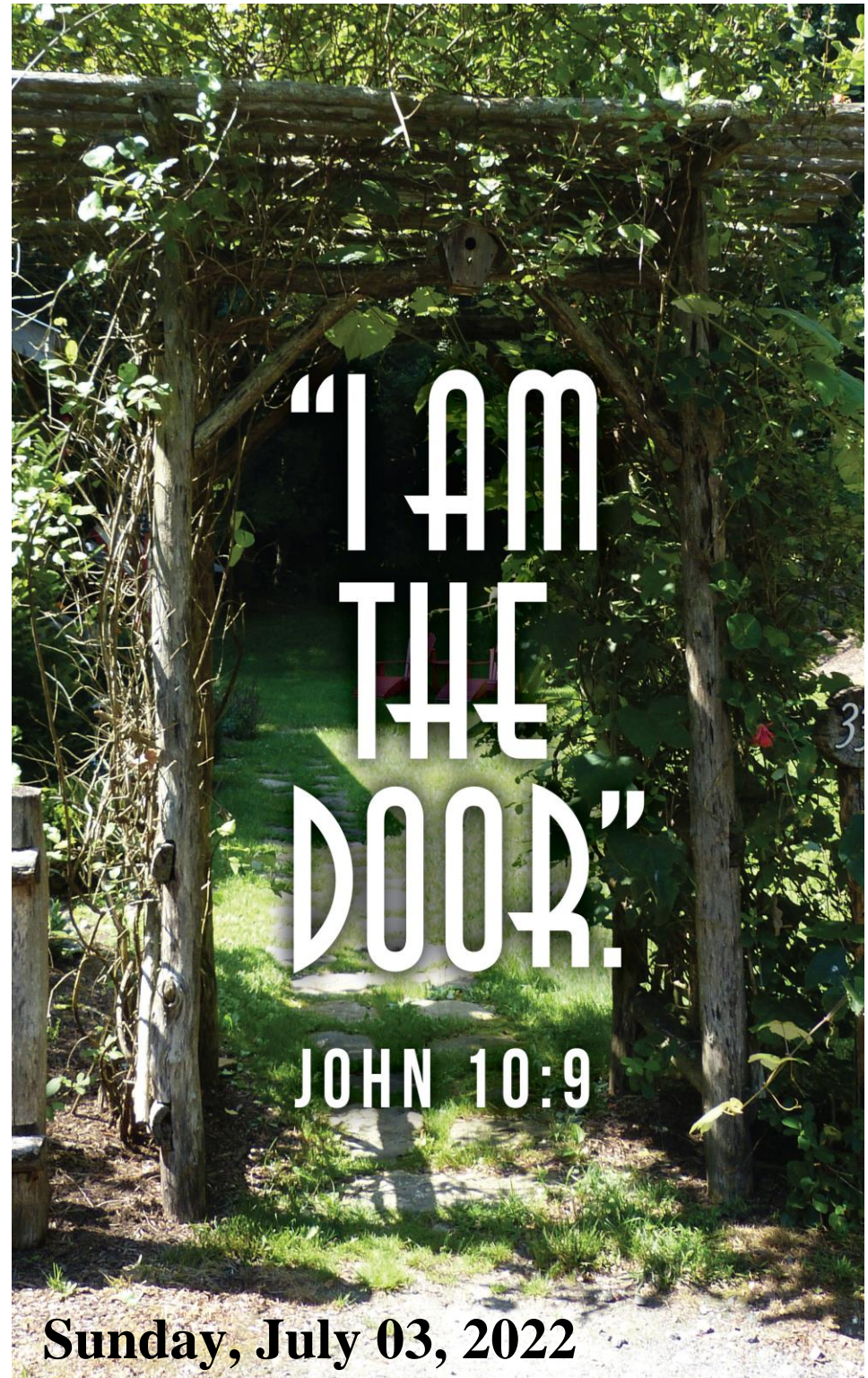

Pantry

Hempfield COB contributed 92 pounds of food items to the pantry in May.

In May the pantry served: 189 children, 248 adults, 107 seniors, for a total 494 served... Many families come to the pantry every week...this gives a grand total of 1,309 people served for the month May.

Forty-nine volunteers gave 472 hours for the month!

Requested items for the month of July are: Cereal, Canned carrots, Canned mixed vegetables, Canned green beans, Canned potatoes, Ramen noodles, Large jelly (please no glass containers), Large peanut butter, Penna pasta.

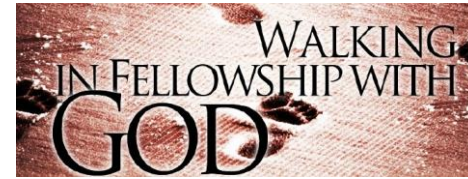

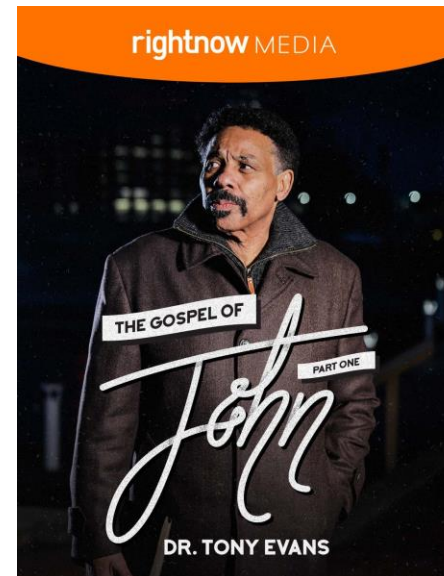
