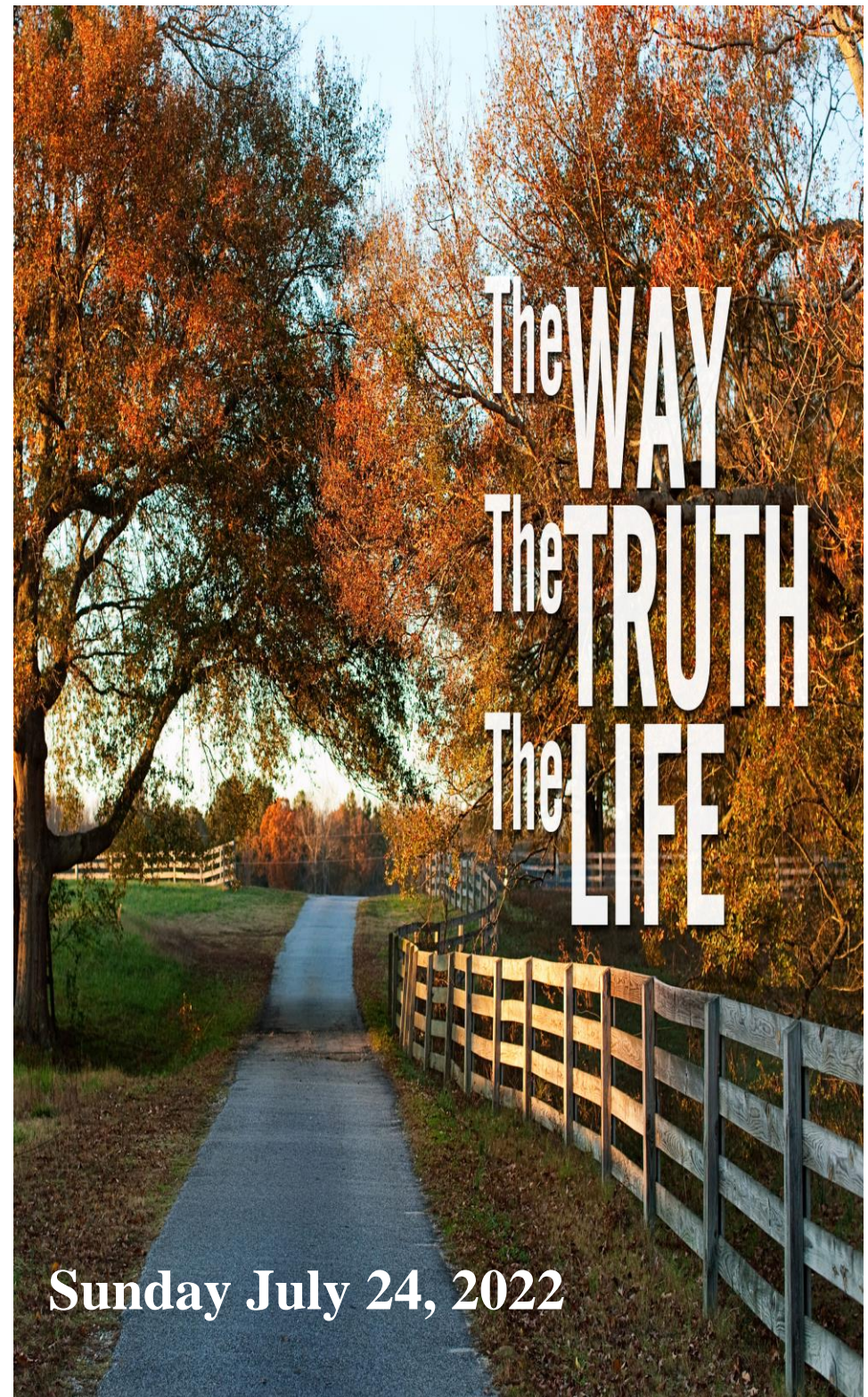

New Donation Station at HCOB for Church World Service (CWS)

– we have launched a new Household Item Donation Station in July to support CWS and their refugee resettlement program.

You can help by donating household items on CWS's list of items that they accept. You can place your donations in the brown wheelbarrow in the narthex or coat closet. (**Food donations** will now be placed in the **shopping cart** in the coat closet.) CWS's donation list is attached to the brown wheelbarrow and is included in the July Herald newsletter. The Outreach Team will deliver donated items to CWS's donation hub on East King Street.

With many refugees arriving with little or no belongings, our donations of household items helps to offset some of the home costs for a new refugee neighbor making a home and rebuilding their life here in Lancaster.

Hempfield started this journey for CWS's refugee resettlement program in December when together we raised over \$8,600. Now we continue to serve our new neighbors in need by accepting donations of household items. THANK YOU

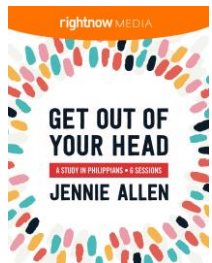


Chicken Barbecue-Rally Day Sept. 11, 2022

Greetings. During May and June 2022, Hempfield COB donated 321 pounds of food and \$1,400 to local food pantries. Totals for the year are 1,095 pounds of food and \$3,600 (money contributions for June to Hempfield are not yet reported).

The Hempfield Area and Manheim Central Pantries continue to provide over 800 clients with groceries each month.

The Hempfield Area Pantry, in cooperation with the Central Pennsylvania Food Bank has introduced electronic client registration and record keeping. This allows volunteers to use iPads to check off clients as they arrive and immediately process any changes in client status. More importantly, once in the system, clients can receive services from any participating food pantry without re-registering.

Special Requests for Hempfield include:

Ramon noodles, canned carrots, canned potatoes, canned mixed vegetables, canned green beans

Special Requests for Manheim include:

Crackers, paper towels, tissues, toilet paper, diapers, canned fruit, baked beans

Both Pantries are in need of cereal, large jelly (no glass containers please), mac and cheese, canned meat (chicken, Spam and tuna), pasta (egg noodles, spaghetti, Penna), pasta sauce, peanut butter, soups, canned vegetables.

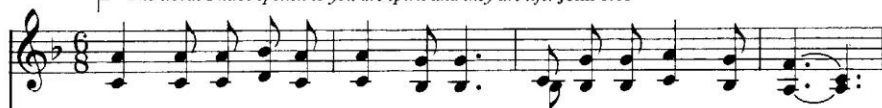
