Your faithful giving has once again contributed to the health and well-being of over 250 families in the Hempfield and Manheim communities. For the year, we donated 2,359 pounds of groceries and household supplies, along with \$6,650. (We're missing October and December money donations to Manheim so the actual money giving is

higher.)

- Since we started keeping records in April 2020, HCOB Food Pantry donations total 8,649 pounds and \$32,900.
