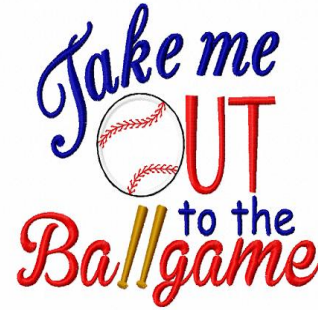

They have enjoyed the many gifts in our church ... the mix of preaching styles, the leadership of Pastor Doug, the variety of music ranging from the rhythms of the Praise Band to the traditional music in the Hymnal.
