

During the past three months HCOB has donated 483 pounds of groceries and \$2,779 to local food pantries. This reflects an increase from last year – thank you.

Client loads at both pantries are holding steady, with new clients registering each month. One highlight for the quarter is the Hempfield Pantry received a \$3,000 Grant from the Abby Longenecker Foundation to support children. This program provides extra food distribution for families with children during the summer months when kids are home from school.
