



## Patterns of Evidence: Journey to Mt. Sinai 1

"Patterns of Evidence: Journey to Mount Sinai 1" is the first in a two-part film series by Patterns of Evidence's award-winning filmmaker, Timothy Mahoney. The Bible records that at Sinai God made a covenant with Moses and the Israelites, and gave them the ten commandments. While the majority of scholars continue

to favor locating Mount Sinai at the traditional site of Jebel Musa (the mountain of Moses) in the southern Sinai Peninsula, many believe the lack of evidence there is good reason to question that thinking. Other scholars question whether these events happened at all.
