

Greetings. During April - June 2024 HCOB has donated 323 pounds of groceries and \$875 to local food pantries. Year to date, donations were 806 pounds of groceries and \$3,654. This reflects a slight decrease from last year.

Client loads at both pantries are seeing the

usual summer fluctuations and new families continue to register. July is a critical month for Pantry operations as all clients are required to update their registration information and re-certify they meet the federal food supplemental income requirements. This annual process qualifies the Pantry to receive significant price discounts from the Central Pennsylvania Food Bank and as a result, allows the Pantry to serve a larger number of our neighbors. **Special Requests for Hempfield include:** canned chicken, one- and two-pound packages of rice, soup, canned chicken noodle soup, canned corn **Special Requests for Manheim include:** Canned chili, canned beef stew, canned carrots, cream of chicken soup, baked beans, diapers, applesauce, spam, canned fruit

Both Pantries need cereal, large jelly (no glass containers please), mac and cheese, canned meat (chicken, Spam and tuna), pasta (egg noodles, spaghetti, Penna), pasta sauce, peanut butter, soups, canned vegetables.


