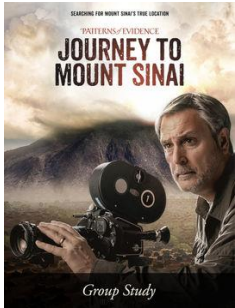

A Second Chance - Church Pictorial

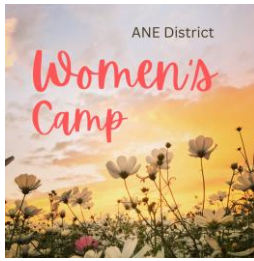
We missed your smiles! If your smiles were “miles away” on May 19th, we are offering a second chance to be in the Church Pictorial.
