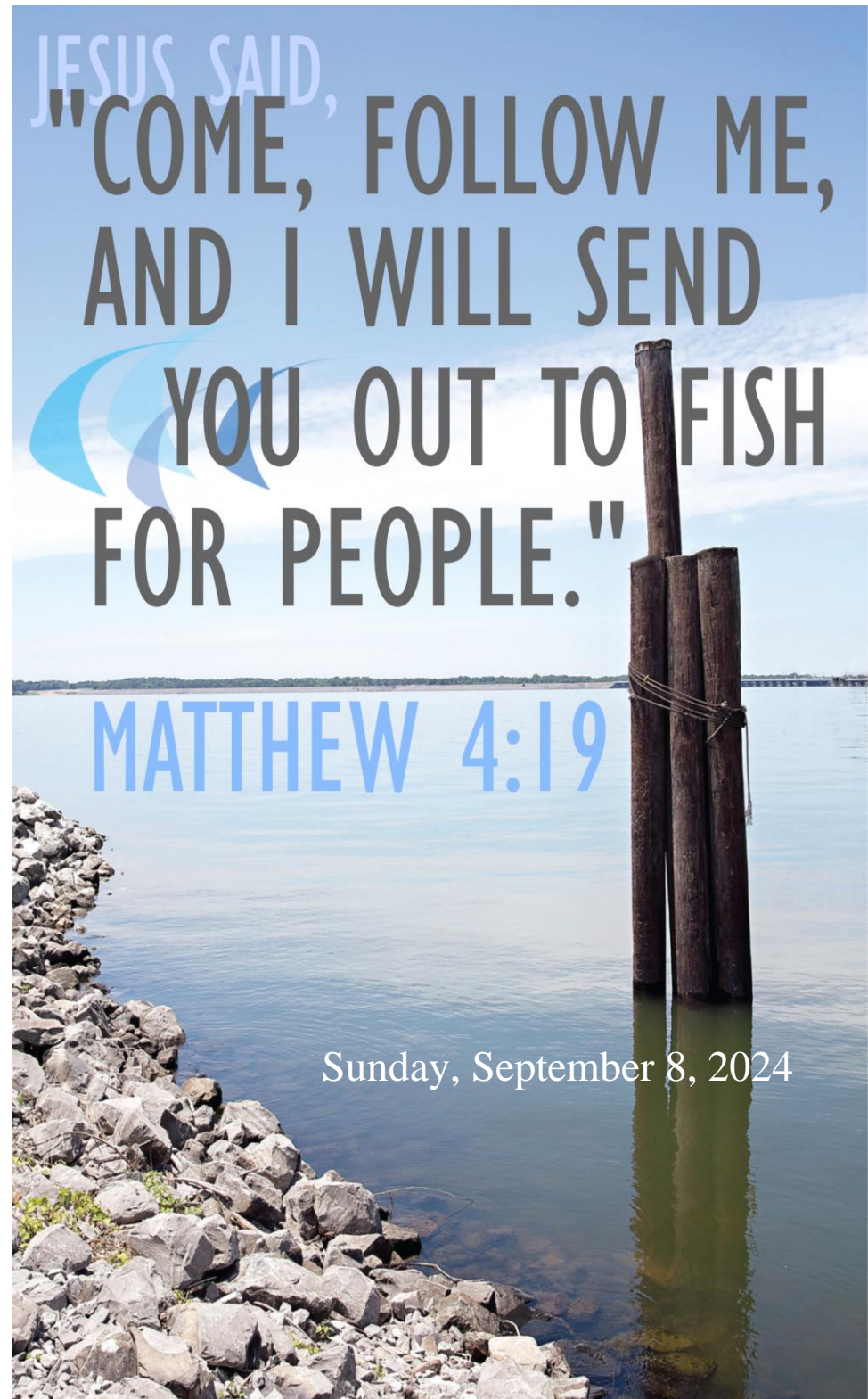

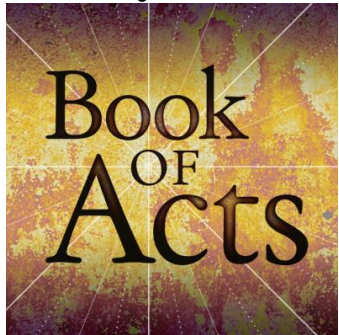
Lunch will be served immediately following the service.
