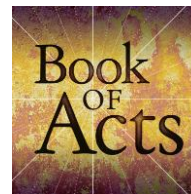

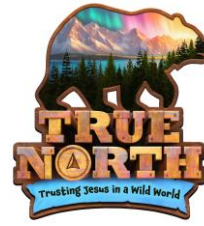


The HOLY SPIRIT continues to work!! The Spirit put the Quilting Ministry on their heart and they responded.
