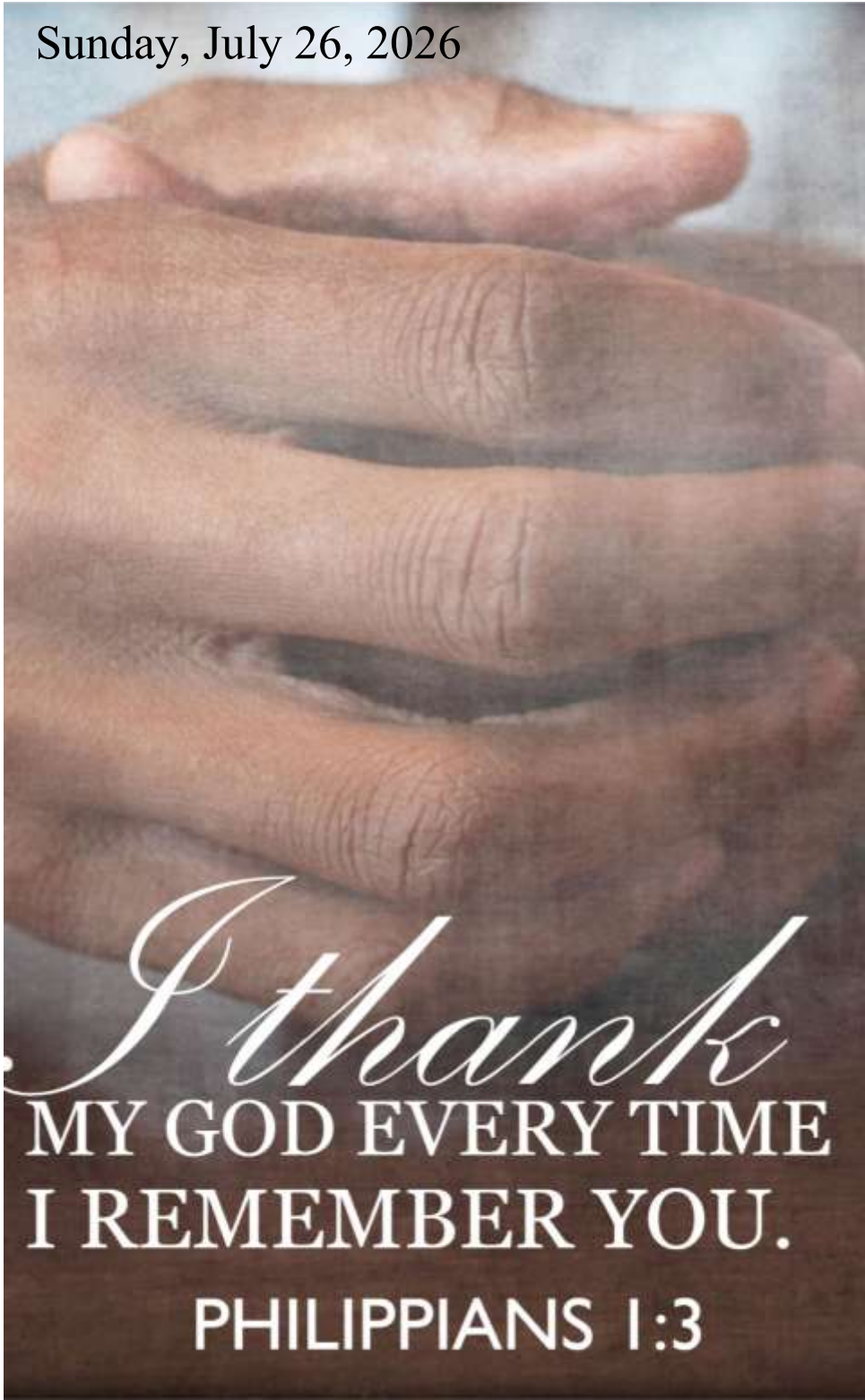

Monday, the door to the church office opened unexpectedly and a young man (not affiliated with our church body) entered wondering if he could borrow our grocery cart. You see, he had a special donation to support our local food pantry partnership. After a while I wondered what in the world he was actually doing outside but sure enough, in he came with the cart pictured and a heart for helping those struggling with food insecurity through his interest in couponing and sharing the fruits of his labor.

Our world is noisy and chaotic and often young people get a bad rap. Today, we challenge you to take a moment, take a deep breath and look up. Where do you see God moving around you? Is it through a bird flitting by in an unexpected place or perhaps a sunrise or sunset. Or maybe, as I experienced today, you'll see God move through the thoughtful offering of a young man with a heart to serve.

Every year, during VBS, our young people talk about God sightings. You know, those things that happen as we move through our days, often the most ordinary of things, that remind us that we are not alone in this world. Rather, they encourage us that God sees us, he knows us, and he is as close as a
